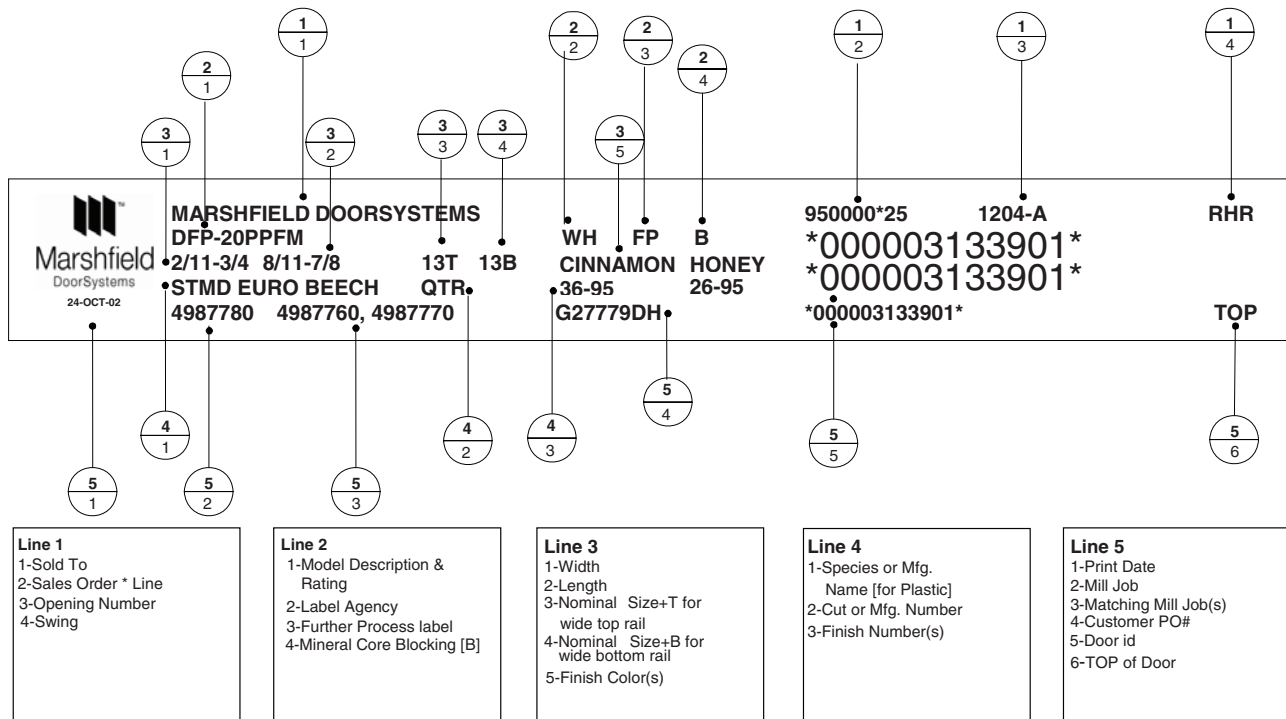

Marshfield DoorSystems Door Label

This TechUpdate is designed to help you understand how to read Marshfield DoorSystems barcode label. Below is an example of a barcode that appears on the top rail of our doors and a description of each line item on the label:



Door Label - Positive Pressure Indicators:

Marshfield's product designations for positive pressure doors are shown by stating the model number and fire rating followed by "PP" for Concealed Intumescent, "PPFM" for Frame Mounted Intumescent, or "PPAF" for Concealed Intumescent with Aluminum Frames. The labeling agency is indicated with a "WH" for Intertek Testing Services – Warnock Hersey or "UL" for Underwriters Laboratories.

Further Process Machining:

The "FP" in the above example indicates that the door is labeled for further process. The "FP" that is represented on the bar code is the only indicator on a door that it is approved for further process by a licensed secondary machiner. If Marshfield DoorSystems had machined the door in this example, the "FP" would not be on the label.

The door in the above example is a *Marshfield Signature Series*™, wood veneer, particleboard core positive pressure door with frame mounted intumescent required and a Intertek Testing Services – Warnock Hersey further process label.
